Minutes of the January 18, 2020 meeting at River Forest Group Camping area in the Ocala National Forest near Deland, are as follows:

Konehead called the meeting to order. He noted that Joe Van and C van were in a bad accident yesterday which totaled the van and the camper, but they are at home resting now. He also noted that Ed Fucci (Zelda) has passed away. He will be leading a caravan from Freeze For All #12 in St. Cloud to Rita's house in Lakeland starting about 8:30 AM on Saturday morning, January 25. From Rita's the caravan will continue to the church for the service.

Minutes of the November 16, 2019 meeting were read and approved. Those minutes said the November 16 meeting was concluded without a formal motion to adjourn. Spooky Tooth made a motion to adjourn that meeting so that this meeting could properly start.

There were 12 clubs present and NO Excused Absence (out of 16 clubs total) during roll call. Coastal showed up after roll call, bringing the total clubs in attendance to 13.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Mook gave the Treasurer's report.

NEWSLETTER REPORT:

Gnarly gave the newsletter report and noted that, with 3 meetings a year, there will be 3 issues of the newsletter per year. This also means that you won't get a January newsletter if your dues for 2021 are not paid by December 31, 2020. It's a lot better to pay at the November meeting. The holidays are hectic enough without having to also see who's paid and get the newsletter done and printed ahead of the January meeting. The deadline for inputs to the next newsletter is April 26.

VAN-IN UPDATES:

Broward March 13 - 15, 2020 - Broward's Laid Back Hillbilly Weekend - Sidewinder's in White Springs. Will do breakfast. PLEASE pre-reg. Even if you can't pre-reg, please let us know you're coming so we know how much meat to prepare. \$20 per van, pre-reg or at the gate'

VAN-IN PROPOSALS:

No new Van-in proposals. Mook noted that we won't be able to get Ross Prairie for an event on Labor Day as it is already booked. A motion by Agnes that we go ahead and book this location (River Forest Group Camping Area) for this time in 2021 was carried by a hand vote.

MEETING DATES the remainder of 2020:

June 2020 - Robinson Ranch, Dunnellon. Nomination of FVC officers for 2021.

November - 2020 Floridian Sandalwood RV resort in St. Cloud - Lew noted that we need at least 10 vans to show up for the night to get a price break. This will be the election of officers for 2021 and the annual pig roast meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

There was no old business

NEW BUSINESS:

Judith noted that the 48th Nats in Minnesota has Winnebago as a corporate sponsor. She asked the group if anyone cared whether there was an actual goodie bag at the Nats. Nobody felt it was necessary. You'd still get your dash plaque, bible, etc. They would just be in an envelope.

Spooky Tooth noted that we need to encourage pre-reg. There should be a difference between pre-reg price and gate price of at least \$10 for eVants.

OPEN DISCUSSION:

Konehead suggested that the FVC give something back to the members, such as paying Saturday night's camping for each van attending the June meeting if the members dues are paid up. A motion was made and discarded after the discussion started. It was noted that a night's camping would cost more than we collect from dues for a member, so that's not really a feasible option. And, it couldn't really be implemented by the June meeting. Judith suggested we give something like a discount or free meal at some future meeting.

Bob (Caravans of Jacksonville) noted that Thumper has Stage 2 and 3 lung cancer. There will be a surprise party for him on February 1 from 5 to 7 PM at Copeland's Restaurant on the South Side of Jacksonville.

Five vanners noted that they were going to the 2020 CofC meeting in Milwaukee. Theme for the Friday night party is to wear anything pink and support their charity. The theme for Saturday night party is "Make a Spectacle of Yourself." Attire is pajamas and oversize glasses.

In response to a question as to how the Nats sites are located, Judith explained the bid system. Prospective hosts make a bid and submit it to the Nats board. If accepted, the site will be what the bid says it will be. The site generally moves around the U.S. There were 732 vans at the last Nats.

Judith noted that, while everyone is invited to the Nats Board meeting (held at every CofC eVant) very few vanners actually show up. She has suggested moving the Nats Board meeting to Saturday, just after the CofC Business meeting. Most of the vanners at this meeting said they would probably go to the meeting if it were held on Saturday after the CofC Business meeting.

Judith made a motion to adjourn and the 54 minute long meeting was concluded.
