Minutes of the June 13, 2020 meeting at Robinson Ranch near Dunnellon, are as follows:

Konehead called the meeting to order at 12:10 PM.

Minutes of the January 18, 2020 meeting were read and approved

There were15 clubs present and NO Excused Absence (out of 16 clubs total) during roll call. Tampa Boogie Vans was accepted as an FVC member club just after roll call, bringing the total number of FVC clubs to 17 (16 clubs in attendance for this meeting).

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Gnarly gave the Treasurer's report, since Mook wasn't there. She wasn't physically at the meeting, but she and Magoo were the only members who availed themselves of the option to attend the meeting virtually, utilizing the ZOOM software option. Gnarly set up the meeting on ZOOM, set up the appropriate wi-fi at the campground, and utilized his laptop throughout the meeting so Mook and Magoo could see and hear the meeting, and be seen and heard in order to provide their input. Gnarly mentioned that, if we are only going to have 2 members attend virtually, maybe setting up the virtual meeting is not really necessary.

NEW BUSINESS:

Lew noted that he had artwork created by a vanner in Australia for some Florida Van Council t-shirts he had made. He cautioned that the logo was made into the cloth. Do NOT use bleach or the design will totally disappear. He handed over the original artwork to Konehead and noted that the artwork now belongs to the FVC to do with as they wish. Cari noted that this was NOT a new official logo for the FVC. That would have to be voted in by the members.

Secretary's Note:

There have only been 2 official logos for the FVC; the original round logo and the "Superman" logo (triangular). The "Superman" logo was voted in, and, after the members decided that the original logo looked the best, it was voted back out. The official (round) logo of the FVC is used as the background image for all of the pages of the FVC website that have a background, except for the "Event Fliers" and "FVC Business" pages. We do have the blue van artwork on the home page of the website, even though it is also NOT an "official" logo. A motion by Cari (seconded by Linard) that the FVC return to having 4 meetings a year was carried with no dissentions. Later in the meeting it was decided that the meetings will be held in January, March, September and November.

<u>Council of Councils (CofC) 2022:</u> The FVC has hosted the CofC meetings in the past, and it has been suggested that we make a bid for the FVC to host the CofC 2022 meeting. Scribe John gave a brief history of how the CofC began to how it is now. Konehead presented the details we have to date and outlined what needs to be done. So far, a hotel has been selected, but won't give a firm commitment on price, etc. until September. Linard noted that it is always good to give back to vanning, and hosting a CofC meeting is one of the ways to do that. FVC has hosted the CofC meeting 8 times in the past.

A motion by Linard (seconded by Brian) that the FVC make a bid to host the 2022 CofC meeting was carried by a unanimous hand vote. Lew noted that as many FVC members as can should be present at the 2021 CofC meeting in Buena Park, CA to show our support for CofC and convince every vanner they can to attend the CofC 2022 meeting.
