It was also noted that Taz, our Van Judge, was not at this meeting because Sandie's serious cancer has taken a turn for the worst.

Minutes of the March 6, 2021 meeting were read and approved by a hand vote.

There were 15 clubs present and ONE Excused Absence (out of 18 clubs total) during roll call.

### **NEWSLETTER REPORT:**

Gnarly gave the newsletter report. Deadline for inputs to the next newsletter is October 10 so we can

FVC Club Roster is getting numerous! Who says vanning is dying...HaH!

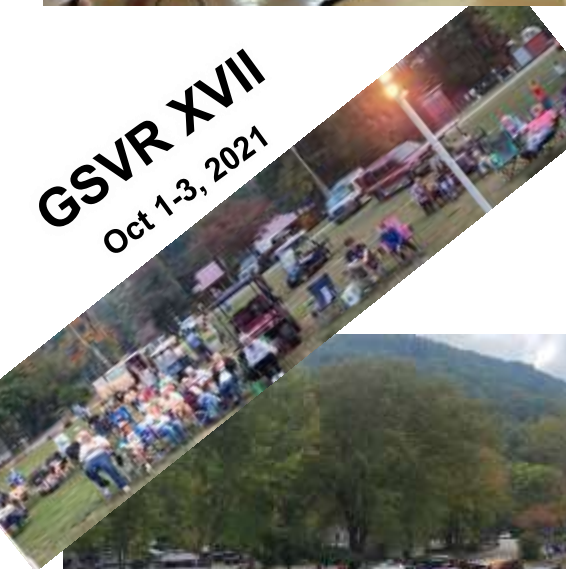
