Dr. up in Georgia said 3 to 6 months rehab. Old farts take longer to heal. Local surgeon didn't give any estimate.

Kind of hard to camp out with one leg immobilized, so I won't be at the January meeting. March meeting is also a bit questionable at this time.

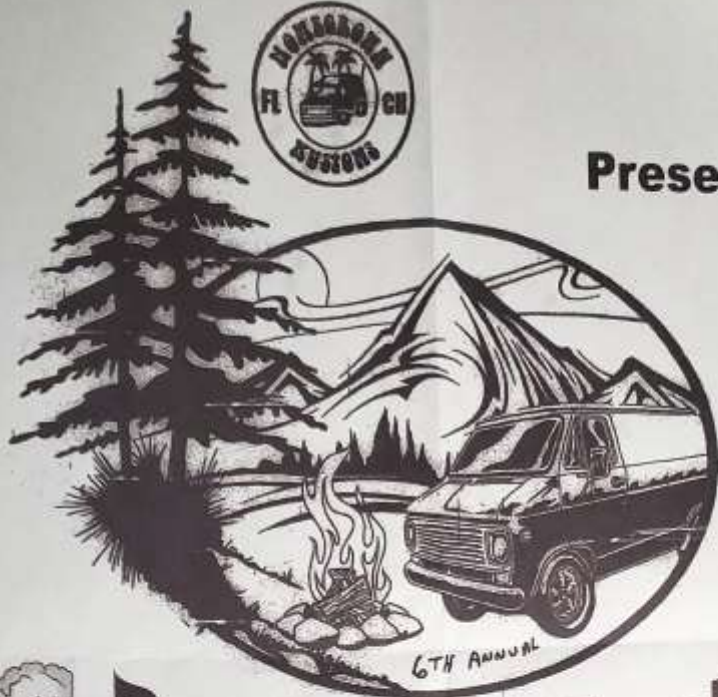

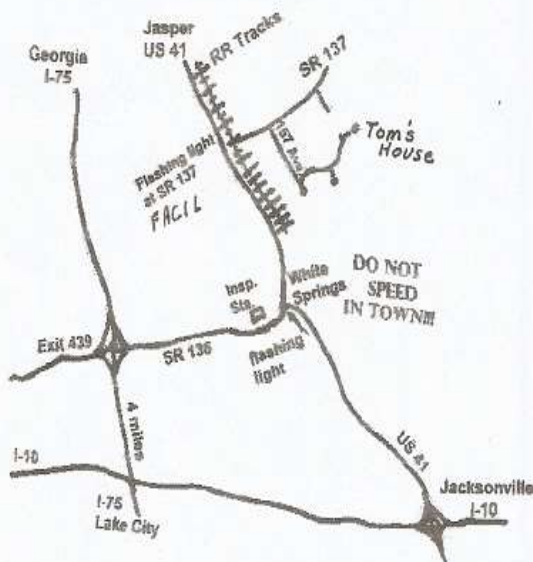
